TECHNICAL SPECIFICATION

1. Objective of the Contract Assignment:

The Objective of the Annual Maintenance Contract (AMC) is to avail expert support from competent agency to maintain and calibrate Online Emission and Effluent Monitoring System. We require experienced service engineer on periodic basis for maintaining and enhancing online monitoring system availability through planned preventive maintenance and fast execution of corrective maintenance.

The details of the scope of work is mentioned below:

1. The installed unit for **Online Emission Monitoring System** at GOAW is as follows:
 - A. Gas Analyser System For the measurement of SO₂,NO,CO (Make -ABB ,Model-EL3020)
 - B.Dust Monitor for PM (Make-SINTROL,Model-S303)

2. The installed unit for **Online Effluent Monitoring System** at GOAW is as follows:
 - A.CON::CUBE(i::SCAN Sensor for BOD,COD,TSS) , Make-S::CAN
 - B.pH Analyser, (Make-ABB, Model-AX400)

2. Scope of Work:

a) Services :

- I. The scope of work includes overall maintenance and including spares of Online Emission and Effluent Monitoring System and data connectivity to UPPCB/CPCB through cloud server and other agencies server as per CPCB latest guidelines.

- II. There shall be one planed visit every month and emergency visits as required.

- III. Cleaning, checking,servicing,calibration,inspection,troubleshooting,replacement of required components, sensor, communication accessories at site wherever required to maintain the system in healthy condition.

- IV. Firm has to maintain all the required spares at their end like -Microprocessor Card ,Touch Screen, Display for con::cube , power card, Analog card, i::scan sensor for COD, BOD, TSS and pH Analyser etc. or as required. Firm has to replace the required spares (if required)within one to two working days after information

given to firm, failing which penalty @2000/day will be imposed over the firm. All spares shall be verified by Works Engineer prior to installation.

- V. Firm has to maintain the good engineering practices during the execution, proper cleaning of the work site will be ensured after completion of the job.
- VI. Scope includes liaising with UPPCB/CPCB/other related agencies. Firm has to ensure 24 x 7 data integrity w.r.t monitoring at GOAW site and UPPCB/CPCB servers.
- VII. Firm has to give response to queries raised by the UPPCB/ CPCB regarding obtained Air and Water pollution consent in the consultation with GOAW, Ghazipur. To obtain air consent from UPPCB/CPCB will be the scope of firm. If any penalty/ compensation will be imposed by any Govt. agency over ETP. Firm will solely responsible to deposit the same
- VIII. Any kind of modification/ up gradation proposed by UPPCB/CPCB for betterment of data analyzing equipment properly. Firm will responsible to install the equipment properly (equipment will be provided by the factory)

b) Spares:

- I. GOAW will not maintain spares for any of installed units. In case any defect reported, firm should come prepared with necessary spares to carry out maintenance activity. It is recommended to keep necessary spares on site.
- II. The old replaced parts shall be returned to firm.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. The bid must contain complete specification of the **Comprehensive Maintenance Contract (CMC) for online Emission and Effluent Monitoring system** clearly showing compliance with prescribed technical specifications.
2. The bid security/EMD as mentioned in Annexure-A in the form of A/c payee demand draft, fixed deposit receipt, Bankers cheque or Bank guarantee from any of the commercial Banks drawn in favour of Assistant Chief Accounts Officer, Govt. Opium and Alkaloid Works, Ghazipur (except Micro and small enterprises (MSEs) as defined in MSE procurement policy issued by department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) or registered with the Central Purchase Organization or the concerned Ministry or department) must be accompanied along with duly signed terms and conditions and self-declaration.`

4. The rates offered will remain valid till the completion of the service of entire quantity of the work. Conditional tenders shall not be accepted.
5. In case, the tenderer withdraws his offer or in the event of tenderer failing to execute, after his tender is accepted, the Earnest Money Deposit furnished by him shall be forfeited without any prejudice to other rights of Govt. of India under any law.
6. In the event of tender being accepted, the Work Order will be placed by the Competent Authority of Govt. Opium & Alkaloid Works, Ghazipur.
7. The successful tenderer to whom Work order is issued, shall have to furnish Security Deposit in the form of Account payee Demand Draft drawn in favour of Assistant Chief Accounts Officer, Govt. Instructions for Online Bid Submission

1. The bidders are required to submit soft copies of their bids electronically on the CPP Portal, using valid Digital Signature Certificates. The instructions given below are meant to assist the bidders in registering on the CPP Portal, prepare their bids in accordance with the requirements and submitting their bids online on the CPP Portal.
2. More information useful for submitting online bids on the CPP Portal may be obtained at <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>

REGISTRATION

- a. Bidders are required to enroll on the e-Procurement module of the Central Public Procurement Portal (URL: <https://eprocure.gov.in/eprocure/app>) by clicking on the link “**Online bidder Enrolment**” on the CPP Portal which is free of charge.
- b. As part of the enrolment process, the bidders will be required to choose a unique username and assign a password for their accounts.
- c. Bidders are advised to register their valid email address and mobile numbers as part of the registration process. These would be used for any communication from the CPP Portal.
- d. Upon enrolment, the bidders will be required to register their valid Digital Signature Certificate (Class II or Class III Certificates with signing key usage) issued by any Certifying Authority recognized by CCA India (e.g. Sify / nCode / eMudhra etc.), with their profile.
- e. Only one valid DSC should be registered by a bidder. Please note that the bidders are responsible to ensure that they do not lend their DSC’s to others which may lead to misuse.
