

Minutes of the Meeting held on 11.01.2023 on compassionate appointment

In pursuance of notice F.No.-I/4/5/NMH-Comp.-Aptt./2021-pt-457-A-B dated 09.01.2023, the meeting of screening committee for compassionate appointment was held on 11.01.2023 virtually, regarding various complaints received in respect of compassionate appointment to be held at GOAW.

The committee comprised of the following members:

The inquiry was again conducted in all the applications for which complaints were raised. The committee took note of the inquiry reports case wise.

1. In case of Smt. Lata Chauhan W/o Late Shri Hari Prasad Chauhan, it was found that she had put her house on mortgage for the money. In mortgage deed it is mentioned that the lender will use the house for own purpose and house rent will not be paid by lender and interest for money received will not be paid by her. Further, there is neither mention of interest rate on money lent in mortgage deed nor there is material evidence of interest income earned by her. In her affidavit submitted earlier she has also mentioned that house was given on mortgage. Therefore, committee is of the view that, as there is no material evidence for house rent received, the allegations made in complaints are not true. However it is noted that as she has received the money in lieu of house, the interest rate earned if any will be considered as income from property. Hence committee decides to calculate the notional interest on mortgage money received as income and deduct the relevant points for it.
2. In case of Shri Narendra Singh Chauhan S/o Late Shri Subhash Singh Chauhan, it has found that the applicant has given false information in sworn affidavit. He has agricultural land in the name of him and his

family members, but he has hidden this fact in the affidavit. Before taking further decision on his application committee is of the view that the applicant may be given opportunity of personal hearing in front of committee.

3. In case of Shri Nitesh Mali S/o Late Shri Nemichand Mali, it has been found that the applicant has given false information in sworn affidavit. Diseased employee's wife has residential property in her name. But applicant has hidden this fact in the affidavit. Before taking further decision on his application committee is of the view that the applicant may be given opportunity of personal hearing in front of committee
