1. The Office of the General Manager, Government Opium and Alkaloid Works Neemuch invites Double-Bid online tenders (Technical & Financial Bid) for disposal of 300 MT Hazardous Waste (Opium Marc-296 MT and ETP Sludge- 4 MT) on Annual Rate Contract basis.

Scope of Work:-

ANNEXURE-A

1. The Scope of Work shall include Collection, Packing, Handling, Transportation and ultimate Disposal of Hazardous Wastes – Opium Marc (Process Residue and Wastes) classified under category 21.1 of the Schedule I and Disposal of Hazardous Waste – ETP Sludge (Chemical Sludge from waste water treatment) classified under category 35.3 of the Schedule I respectively of the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and extant provisions under Environment Protection Act 1986, as may be amended and approved by the Central Pollution Control Board and also the Pollution control boards of the Generating State as well as the disposal State.

2. **Wastes Description:-** Govt. Opium & Alkaloid Works, Neemuch is a Bulk Drug Industry engaged in the manufacture of alkaloids & their derivatives from opium. Two types of solid wastes are generated in the process, namely Opium Marc & ETP Sludge.

2.1 Opium Marc: Opium marc is a process residue, which is generated during processing of Opium. It is a hazardous waste as per Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016. Opium marc is listed in waste category no. 28.1 (Process residue and waste generated from production / formulation of drugs/ pharmaceuticals & health care products) of Schedule I of the said rules. Calorific value of opium marc is about 2335.9 K.cal/kg.

2.2 ETP Sludge: ETP sludge is also another hazardous waste which is obtained from Effluent Treatment Plant. ETP Sludge is listed in the waste category no. 35.3 of Schedule I of the said rules. Calorific value of ETP Sludge is about 1495.6K.cal/kg.

3. **Contract Period:-** GOAW, Neemuch intends to execute an Annual Rate Contract for one year.
4. **Required Terms of Delivery, Destination and preferred mode of Transportation:-** The Hazardous Wastes presently stored in Marc Shed to be lifted & loaded from GOAW, Neemuch as intimated by our Production Manager on working days. The vehicles carrying the material should have proper papers including valid registration/ insurance of vehicle and valid license of the Driver. The Contractor/ Successful Bidder shall be responsible for safe transport of the Hazardous Waste. All security norms as applicable to be followed.
5. **Mode of Transportation:-** Transportation of hazardous wastes should conform to all statutory norms/ regulations and it shall be the responsibility of the contractor.

GENERAL INFORMATION FOR THE TENDERERS

1. With reference to this office tender notice issued vide F.NO. GOAF/I/(22)/92/2025 dated 08.01.2026, tenders are invited for disposal of Hazardous Waste Opium Marc and ETP Sludge and It is a hazardous waste as per Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016.

2. Last date for uploading of tenders is up to 18:00 Hrs. of 28.01.2026. Tenders uploaded after due date, time and not in prescribed tender document will not be considered. The tenders are to be submitted (Uploaded) in the prescribed Tender Documents, in respective covers.

3. Tenders uploaded up to prescribed time and date will be opened on 29.01.2026 at 15:00 Hrs.

4. Technical Bid in the prescribed format as per Annexure C shall be duly filled in and signed by the authorized signatory and uploaded online by the bidder in Cover-I along with the self-attested and stamped scanned copies of the following documents: -

6. If it is noticed that the goods supplied do not conform to the scope/ specification of the order, GOAW, Neemuch will take action as per terms and conditions of this tender.
7. Earnest Money of the unsuccessful bidder shall be released after finalization of the tender, as per General Financial Rules 2017. Interest on the Earnest Money Deposit / Security Deposit will not be paid on any score, what-so-ever.
8. A Self declaration on stamp paper shall be submitted duly notarized to the effect that the firm is not BLACK LISTED for Government transaction by any Department / PSU of Government of India.
9. The General Manager, Govt. Opium & Alkaloid Works, Neemuch reserves the right to reject or accept any tender without assigning any reason.
10. Disposal quantity of Hazardous waste can be increased or decreased up to 25% of the total quantity.

Section IV

GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. Tenders not strictly in conformity with the specifications of the work given in the tender form shall not be considered.
2. The rates offered will remain valid till the completion of entire quantity of contract or the validity of Annual Rate Contract. Conditional tenders shall not be accepted.
3. In the event of tender being accepted, the Annual Rate Contract will be placed by the Competent Authority of Govt. Opium & Alkaloid Works, Neemuch.
4. The successful tenderer to whom annual rate contract is issued, shall have to furnish Security Deposit in the form of Account payee Demand Draft Drawn in favour of Assistant Chief Accounts Officer, Govt. Opium and Alkaloid Works, Neemuch/ Bank Guarantee/ Fixed Deposit Receipt from a commercial bank at the rate of 5% of the total value of the order. Such Security deposit should remain valid for a period of sixty days after the successful completion of the contract.
5. The rates should be quoted on F.O.R. Neemuch basis (inclusive of all taxes/levies applicable). Neemuch is located 135 km from Ratlam (MP) and 55Kms from Chittorgarh (Rajasthan).
6. The bid security declaration should be submitted as per format given in Annexure – E (except Micro and small enterprises (MSEs) as defined in MSE procurement policy issued by department of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSME) or registered with the Central Purchase Organisation or the concerned Ministry or department).
7. The rates quoted should be valid for a period of 1 year from the date of opening of tender. The contract can be extended further for one more year on mutual consent from both the parties i.e. the Contractor and the General Manager, GOAW, Neemuch.
8. In case of delay or failure to Disposal of Hazardous Waste Opium Marc and ETP Sludge as per standards prescribed and accepted by tenderer, the General Manager of this Works without prejudice to any other rights available under the law shall have the option:-
 - (i) Either to recover from the contractor liquidated damages up to 0.05% per week of the contract value ; or
 - (ii) To get the work done from any other source at the risk and cost of the contractor ; or
 - (iii) To cancel the contract without any liability on either side.
9. In case of exigencies, unforeseen circumstances the General Manager reserves the right to cancel the work order for whole work or part of it by way of one month notice without assigning any reason.

10. Legal proceedings, if any, emanating from this contract shall fall within the jurisdiction of the competent court of Neemuch, District Neemuch, State Madhya Pradesh.
11. The transportation shall be in accordance with the provisions of the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules 2008, and the rules made by the Central Government under the Motor Vehicle Act, 1988 and other guidelines issued from time to time.
12. In case, the tenderer withdraws his offer or in the event of tenderer failing to execute, after his tender is accepted, the Earnest Money Deposit furnished by him shall be forfeited without any prejudice to other rights of Govt. of India under any law.
13. **Validity of Bids:** The Bids should remain valid for 1 year from the date of Financial bid opening.
14. **Rejection of Bids:** Canvassing by the Bidder in any form, unsolicited letter and post-tender correction may invoke summary rejection. Conditional tenders will be rejected. Non-compliance of applicable General Information and Instruction will disqualify the Bid.
15. If any tenderer submit more than one financial bid, the bid would be liable to be rejected outrightly.
16. Canvassing for obtaining tender will be disqualified the bidder from tender process.

17. Force Majeure Clause:-

- (a) Neither party shall bear responsibility for the complete or partial non- performance of any of its obligations (except for failure to pay any sum which has become due on account of receipt of services under the provisions of the present contract), if the non- performance results from such Force Majeure circumstances as Flood, Fire, Earthquake and other acts of God as well as War, military operations, blockade, Acts or Actions of State Authorities or any other circumstances beyond the parties control that was not known earlier and have arisen after the conclusion of the present contract.
- (b) In such circumstances the time stipulated for the performance of an obligation under the present contract is extended correspondingly for the period of time of action of these circumstances and their consequences.
- (c) The party for which it becomes impossible to meet obligations under this contract due to Force Majeure conditions, is to notify in written form the other party of the beginning and cessation of the above circumstances immediately, but in any case, not later than 5days from the moment of thei9r beginning.
- (d) The Certificate of a Chamber of Commerce (Commerce and Industry) or other competent authority or organization of the respective country shall be a sufficient proof of commencement and cessation of the above circumstances.
- (e) If the impossibility of complete or partial performance of an obligation lasts for more than 6 months, either party hereto reserves the right to terminate the contract totally or partially upon giving prior written notice of 30 days to the other party of the intention to terminate without any liability other than reimbursement on the terms provided in the agreement for the goods received.

18. Section V

Special Instructions to Tenderers/ Measures for Pollution Control

- 1) The Contractor must take adequate steps while handling transportation and disposal of hazardous wastes in the manner as prescribed in the Hazardous Waste (Management, Handling and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2008, subsequent Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and as prescribed by the Central Pollution Control Board, State Pollution Control Boards (generator and transit) as well as by the pollution Control Board of the State of disposal. All necessary approval/ registration/ authorization/ submission of Compliance Report etc., to various authorities shall be the responsibility of the Contractor in co-operation and co-ordination with the Company Officials.
- 2) All clauses to be followed by the contractor to obtain grant of registration for recycling, re-processing, re-using and ultimate disposal of hazardous waste from Central Pollution Control Board.
- 3) The Contractor should follow all guidelines issued by Central Government, State Government and Central Pollution Control Board from time to time for standards of performance for ultimate disposal.
- 4) The Contractor should follow all guidelines, as applicable, in the Form-2 granted to GOAW, Neemuch authorization to operate a facility for generation, collections, storage and disposal of hazardous wastes.
- 5) The Contractor shall be responsible for Storage, Treatment and ultimate disposal of Collected Hazardous waste in accordance with the Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and guidelines issued by CPCB.
- 6) Hazardous wastes to be lifted from GOAW, Neemuch site and disposed at Contractor's site as prescribed by Pollution Control Board.
- 7) The waste Hazardous waste should be disposed only in the manner as specified by the Central Pollution Control Board and PCB of State of disposal.
- 8) During the period of contract, the contractor should ensure that all rules of Central Pollution Control Board and State Pollution Control Boards & guidelines of MOEF are complied with.
- 9) Any penalty/action imposed by SPCB/ CPCB or any agency during the period of contract or as regard with task for which the work order will be placed has to be borne by the contractor only.
- 10) All provisions mentioned in the Hazardous Wastes (Management, Handling and Transboundary) Rules, 2008 as well as subsequent Hazardous and Other Wastes (Management and Transboundary Movement) Rules, 2016 and any other applicable rules shall be strictly followed.
- 11) The Contractor has to obtain necessary authorization/ permission from states through which the hazardous wastes shall be transported. All necessary NOCs should be obtained well before the commencement of the contract.
- 12) The Contractor/ Successful Bidder shall be responsible for safe transport of the Hazardous Waste.
- 13) In Case of any accident during transport, Contractor shall inform GOAW, Neemuch, the State Pollution Control Board of the state where the accident has occurred, CPCB and State Pollution Control Board where Hazardous waste is disposed, apart from taking necessary immediate remedial action.
- 14) The contractor at his own cost will arrange permission for transport, if any. The transport of the hazardous wastes shall be in accordance with the provisions of the HWM rules in force and the

rules made by Central Government under the Motor vehicles Act, 1988 and other guidelines issued from time to time in this regard.

- 15) In case of transport of Hazardous wastes for final disposal to a facility for treatment, storage and ultimate disposal existing in a State other than the State where the hazardous waste is generated, the party shall obtain 'Mo Objection Certificate' from the State Pollution Control Board of both the States.
- 16) In Case of Transport of hazardous wastes through a State other than the State of origin or destination, the party shall intimate the concerned State Pollution Control Boards before they hand over the hazardous wastes to the transporter.
- 17) Packing and Labeling – The operator of the treatment, storage and disposal facility or recycler shall ensure that the hazardous wastes are packaged and labeled, based on the composition in a manner suitable for safe handling, storage and transport as per the guidelines issued by the Central Pollution Control Board from time to time. The labeling and packaging shall be easily visible and be able to withstand physical conditions and climatic factors.
